GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

LANGUAGE	Abstract must be typed and presented in British English.
TOPIC OF PAPER	General anaesthesia, regional anaesthesia, specialty anaesthesia, pain, perioperative medicine, critical care medicine, education, history of anaesthesia, basic science related to anaesthesia, organizational issues and related topics.
FONT	Use font type “Times New Roman”, Font Size “12”.
WORD LIMIT	The abstract must be written within 300 words, excluding title and the names of the author(s) and their institutions.
CONTENT	The submitted abstracts must contain the following:- Introduction: State the main objective of the study. Materials and methods: Briefly describe the design of the study and how it was conducted. Results: Present the main results with appropriate statistics. Conclusion: Limit the conclusions to those that are directly supported by the results.
TITLE	The title of the abstract must be typed in CAPITAL LETTERS with the exception of scientific names, which should be in upper and lower case forms and italicized.
PRESENTING AUTHOR DETAILS	The presenting author's name must be underlined. The presenting author's name, designation, institution, address, telephone and email address must be provided. Presenting authors must be registered for the conference. Only registered delegates will be allowed to present. Author must mention the type of presentation they wish to make: poster or oral – final decision lies within the scientific committee.
DEADLINE	30 th January 2019
ACCEPTANCE	Presenting author shall be notified of the status of the abstract after being reviewed by the committee via email. Authors selected for oral & poster presentation will be informed. Communication will only be made via email only on this regard. Hence inclusion of email address along with abstract is mandatory. The scientific committee of SANCON 2019 will not answer and responsible for any conclusion drawn from the papers or scientific work presented during conference. Any possible legal issues or interest related to the articles and published papers or papers under publication will not be under any form of legal responsibility of the scientific committee SANCON 2019. The presenter/authors must be responsible in case of such conflicts. The scientific work already published in journal will not be entertained.
REGISTRATION	Registration for conference is not mandatory for abstract submission. However if abstract or paper gets selected, then registration for the conference is mandatory.
